ORDINANCE NO. O-16-30

AMENDING CHAPTER 925, REFUSE COLLECTION, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, City Council desires to amend certain sections of Chapter 925, Refuse Collection, of the Codified Ordinances, in order make the landfill more cost effective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

[Additions to the CODIFIED ORDINANCES are in **bold** and deletions are lined through or noted below]:

- Section 1. That the following section of Chapter 925, Refuse Collection, of the Codified Ordinances, be, and hereby are, amended to read in full as follows:
- 925.24 CLASSIFICATIONS AND RATES FOR REFUSE COLLECTIONS, CURBSIDE RECYCLING, YARD WASTE, AND LANDFILL AND COMPOST AREA TIPPING FEES.
- I. Commencing after June 1, 2009 2016, in addition to fees levied by the OEPA and the Clinton County Solid Waste Management District as set forth in Section 925.24 II

 (a) and (b), every householder and commercial establishment creating refuse shall pay for the furnishing of the service of collection in accordance with the following schedule of monthly rates:

(b) Commencing after November 30, 1994, every householder and commercial establishment creating refuse shall also pay their share of the current fees assessed to the City of Wilmington by the Clinton County Solid Waste Management District. Those current fees are as follows:

- (c) The Landfill Tipping Fee Schedule in Sections 935.24 II (a) and (b) includes all fees assessed to the City of Wilmington by other entities, including, but not limited to, fees from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Clinton County Solid-Waste Management District. All tipping fees assessed to the City of Wilmington by other entities, including but not limited to, fees from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Clinton County Solid Waste Management District are included in the fee schedule.
- (d) After adoption of and upon any changes or amendments to this section, the landfill manager shall publish the schedule in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipal corporation one time. The fee schedule shall be posted continually throughout the year in a conspicuous place at the landfill offices as well as on the City of Wilmington website.
- (e) Any amendments or changes to Section 925.24 II (a) and (b) to the fee schedule shall be prepared by the Sanitation Superintendent, in cooperation with the Service Director and the Mayor, and are subject to Council approval by Council.

III. CURBSIDE RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE BAG COLLECTION FEES

(a) Yard Waste Bags

IV. COMPOST AREA TIPPING FEES FOR YARD WASTE

- (a) <u>Commercial Haulers of Yard Waste</u>. <u>Commercial hHaulers of yard waste will</u> be charged twenty dollars (\$20.00) per vehicle per trip to tip at the City compost area regardless of where the yard waste originated five dollars (\$5.00) per cubic yard for yard waste.
- (b) Non-commercial Haulers of Yard Waste. Non-commercial haulers of yard waste originating outside the City will be charge ten dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle per trip to tip at the compost area. There is no charge for non-commercial haulers of yard waste originating from inside the City.
- Section 2. That each and every section of Chapter 925, Refuse Collection, of the Codified Ordinances, except those sections identified and amended in Section 1 of this ordinance, are hereby ratified and republished and incorporated herein by reference as though fully rewritten herein.
