

RESOLUTION NO. R-16-18

AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF A PARTNERSHIP WITH CLINTON COUNTY TO ACT AS THE OFFICIAL GRANTEE FOR THE FY 2016 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency, Office of Community Development (OCD) is encouraging local eligible communities to form a partnership to apply for and administer the FY 2016 CHIP grant; and

WHEREAS, the formulation of a partnership will enable the City of Wilmington and Clinton County to be eligible to apply for \$800,000 in FY 2016 CHIP funds; and

WHEREAS, OCD is requiring that one entity of the partnership take the lead and be the official Grantee.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Wilmington enters into a partnership with Clinton County to prepare the application and administer the FY 2016 CHIP grant.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Wilmington hereby designates Clinton County as the official Grantee for the FY 2016 CHIP program.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of application deadlines and is necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and accordingly, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
