

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-15

**ADOPTING FINAL LEGISLATION FOR A "SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL" PROJECT
TO INSTALL SIDEWALKS ON TRUESDELL STREET**

WHEREAS, the following Final Resolution is enacted by the City of Wilmington, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority of Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of October 2011, the LPA enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

The project consists of installing sidewalk along Truesdell Street, including curb ramps, crosswalks and school signage, lying within the City of Wilmington; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the preliminary engineering and construction phases of the improvement, less the amount of Federal-aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration U.S. Department of Transportation, and further, the City agrees to assume and bear 100% of the cost of Right of Way, excluding in-house right of way charges incurred by the State.

In view of the fact that the LPA's share of the project is now estimated in the amount of Thirty Thousand One Hundred Ninety Five and 00/100 Dollars, (\$30,195.00) less Toll Revenue Credit in the amount of Thirty Thousand One Hundred Ninety Five and 00/100 Dollars, (\$30,195.00) leaving a balance of Zero and 00/100 Dollars, (\$0.00) therefore, the City will not be required to deposit any funds at this time. The LPA's ultimate share of the cost will be determined when final actual costs and allocations are determined.

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of same to this legislative authority; and

WHEREAS, this Legislative Authority desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:**


Section 1. That the LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

Section 2. That the LPA enter into a contract with the State, and that Service Director be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract for improving the described project.


Section 3. That the LPA transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

Section 4. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


