

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-20

AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN ELECTRICITY PURCHASE CONTRACT WITH INTERSTATE GAS SUPPLY, INC. REGARDING RECEIVING AN ENERGY COST DISCOUNT FOR QUALIFYING CITY ACCOUNTS

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio and the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) have made certain options available pertaining to the supply of electric generation and transmission supply services, and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington is currently under a Power Supply Agreement with DPL Energy for electric supply to city accounts; and

WHEREAS, The DPL Energy division of Dayton Power & Light was recently acquired by Interstate Gas Supply, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wilmington desires to purchase electric generation and transmission supply services from Interstate Gas Supply, Inc., under terms favorable to the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed on behalf of the City to enter into an Electricity Purchase Contract with Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (IGS) for electric generation and transmission services for the City accounts designated in said agreement (which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as "**Exhibit A**").

Section 2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


