



## Clinton County Full & Part Time Employment: 1969 - 2014






#### **Annual Employment Growth Rate**



#### **Clinton County Employment – 5 Largest Industries**




#### **Median Household Income**




#### **Wilmington Income Distribution**








## Workforce Decomposition of 18 - 64 Population Clinton County, Ohio


#### **Distribution of Job Locations in Clinton County**

















