US 17 from South of Cypress Gardens Boulevard to South of Havendale Boulevard, Winter Haven, Florida

Project Description:

The Florida Department of Transportation will be making improvements on US 17 from south of Cypress Gardens Boulevard to south of Havendale Boulevard in Winter Haven, Florida. The improvements under this contract consist of:

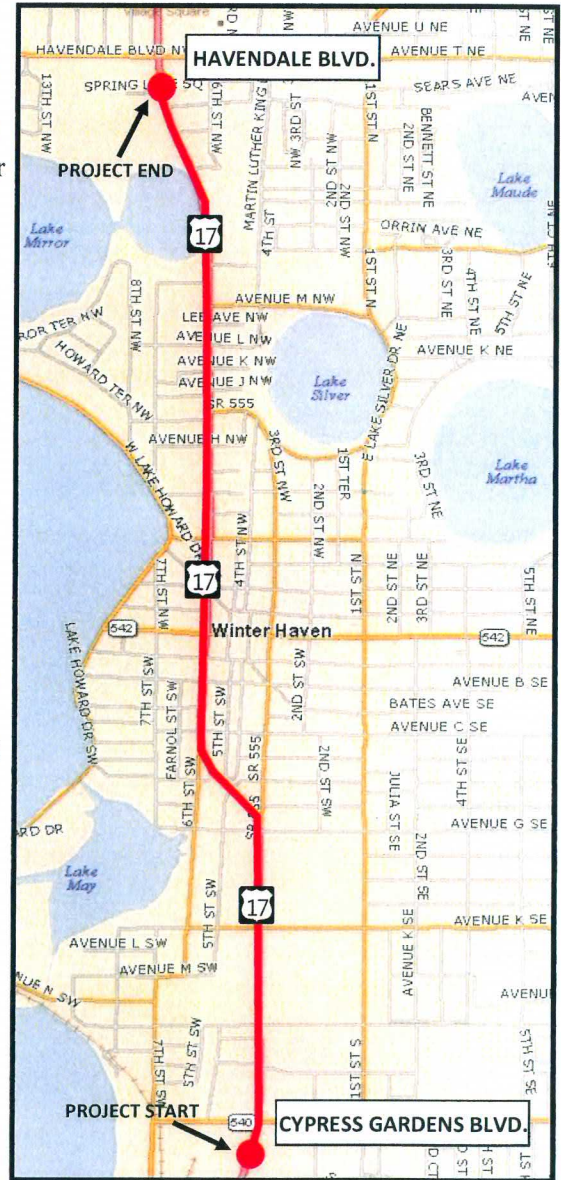
- Removal of old asphalt (milling)
- Resurfacing the roadway
- Curb and gutters
- Drainage improvements
- Sidewalk
- Signalization
- Signing and pavement markings

What to Expect During Construction:

Daytime and Nighttime Work: The contractor will be performing construction activities during daytime hours and will also be working at various times during nighttime hours. Motorists may experience temporary delays.

Lane Closures: Lane closures will not be permitted between the hours of 6 a.m. and 7 p.m. with the exception of continuous daytime lane closures to perform drainage activities. Daytime lane closures will be restricted to 10 weekdays from Sunday through Thursday.

Speed Limit: Speed limits will not be reduced during construction.
