RESOLUTION 2008-12

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PURCHASE TWO
NEW POLICE CRUISERS THROUGH THE STATE BIDDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Police and Fire Committee having determined it to be necessary and recommending to Council that two 2008 police cruisers be purchased by the Village, and

WHEREAS, Council having determined that the lowest and best price will be obtained through the State Bidding Program, the purchase to be made through Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury of Van Wert, OH for two 2008 Ford Crown Victorias at a cost of \$45,002.00 less trade-ins. The total cost to the Village of the vehicles, which includes the cost of changeover of radios, lights, shotgun equipment, etc. will be \$57,442.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMBERLEY VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Council hereby approves, authorizes and directs the Village Manager to contract through the STATE OF OHIO BIDDING PROGRAM for the purchase, through Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury of Van Wert, OH for two Ford Crown Victorias at a cost of \$45,002.00 less trade-ins. The total cost to the Village of the vehicles, which includes the cost of changeover of radios, lights, shotgun equipment, etc. will be \$57,442.00.

SECTION 2: The cost of such police vehicles shall be paid from the General Fund.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
