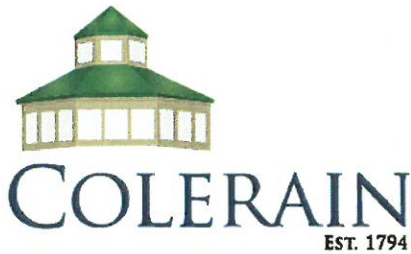

NORTHWEST LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND/OPERATING LEVY ENDORSEMENT

- Whereas the Northwest Local School District Board of Education has approved a resolution to seek voter approval for a combined bond/operating levy on November 3, 2015; and
- Whereas the Northwest Local School District intends to issue bonds in the amount of \$76 million dollars for a period of time not to exceed 35 years for the purpose of new construction and renovation; and
- Whereas the Northwest Local School District plans to construct 3 new elementary schools in the amount of \$64 million which would replace 5 existing buildings; and
- Whereas the Northwest Local School District plans to address the most urgent needs in the remaining buildings through renovations amounting to \$21 million; and
- Whereas the Northwest Local School District has identified operating needs amounting to 1.00 mills, and
- Whereas the Northwest Local School District proposes to replace an existing operating levy amounting to 4.52 mills with a combination levy amounting to 3.82 mills allowing for an overall millage reduction of .70 mills, and
- Whereas the Colerain Township Board of Trustees recognizes that strong schools play a vital role in the life of the community, and finds that this proposed issue supports our vision of "Delivering Excellence to a Best in Class Community," now therefore,

1. The resolution is requested to serve as an amendment to the current Colerain Township “Noise Resolution.” The request allows the Township to thoroughly address complaints from residents associated with shooting ranges. The amendment provides the ability to investigate a “Noise” complaint utilizing the Ohio Division of Wildlife established sound decibel levels.

Colerain Township Department of Fire and EMS

Action: Personnel

1. Request authorization for a change of pay status for Jeff Benzing from Firefighter Paramedic to the *Firefighter Paramedic Fire Apparatus Operator* classification at a new pay rate of \$16.98 per hour effective Sunday October 25, 2015.
2. Request authorization for a change of status for Michael Davis, Firefighter Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) to the *Firefighter Paramedic* classification at a new pay rate of \$15.62 per hour retroactive to April 26, 2015. His retroactive pay is the result of an administrative oversight.
3. Request authorization for a change of status/change of pay for Stephanie McMahon. The Board previously approved FF/Medic McMahon as a IIB employee. RESOLUTION NO. _____-15

AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 9-03 FOR CONTROL OF NOISE AT SHOOTING RANGES

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, passed Resolution No. 9-03: Resolution For Control of Noise, on January 28, 2003, controlling various noise and sound amplification devices within Colerain Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township has determined that excessively loud noise from shooting ranges in areas within Colerain Township constitutes a nuisance and is detrimental to the public health, welfare, safety, and quality of life within Colerain Township; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §504.04 provides for the exercise of all powers of local self-government within the unincorporated area of the township ; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code §505.172 authorizes Boards of Township Trustees to adopt regulations and orders that are necessary to control noise within the unincorporated territory of the township that is generated at any premises to which a D permit has been issued by the Division of Liquor Control or that is generated within any areas zoned for residential use; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §1533.84 the Chief of the Division of Wildlife is directed to adopt rules establishing generally accepted standards for shooting ranges, including standards for the limitation and suppression of noise, standards for the hours of operation and standards for public safety; and

WHEREAS, the conditions and noise levels at shooting ranges in the unincorporated areas of the Township are negatively impacting the adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township desires to establish uniform regulations for shooting ranges in its territory; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §504.12, the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township desires to amend Resolution No. 9-03 to include additional language as set forth herein, regulating the noise or sound levels produced by shooting ranges in the township in order to prevent hearing damage and eliminate nuisance noise complaints; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, as follows:

1. The Board specifically finds and hereby determines noise and sound levels from shooting ranges inside the township are excessive and are dangerous to adjacent properties and the health and safety of the residents of Colerain Township; and
2. That the Colerain Township Board of Trustees hereby orders the owners of said shooting ranges operating within Colerain Township to comply with the rules promulgated by the Chief of the Division of Wildlife and set forth herein, that these rules shall amend Resolution 9-03 to include the following noise and sound level regulations for shooting ranges within Colerain Township:
 1. Placing the sound measuring receiver at the boundaries of the range property, sound levels shall not exceed ninety decibels dB(A) for one hour out of twenty-four hours or eighty-five decibels dB(A) for eight hours out of twenty-four hours.
3. That Resolution No. 9-03 is hereby readopted in its entirety with the addition of the standards set forth herein.
4. Whoever violates this Resolution shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00.
5. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; and
6. That the Board by a majority vote hereby dispenses with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days and hereby authorizes the adoption of the Resolution upon its first reading.

WHEREAS Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87 provides that, at least seven days prior to providing for the abatement, control or removal of any vegetation, garbage, refuse, or debris, the Board of Trustees shall notify the owner of the land and any holders of liens of record upon the land; and

WHEREAS Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87 provides that, if the Board of Trustees determines within twelve consecutive months after a prior nuisance determination that the same owner's maintenance of vegetation, garbage refuse, or other debris on the same land in the township constitutes a nuisance, at least four days prior to providing for the abatement, control or removal of the nuisance, the Board must send notice of the subsequent nuisance determination to the landowner and to any lienholders of record by first class mail; and

WHEREAS In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87, the Township Trustees have the authority to contract to abate the nuisances and have the costs incurred assessed to the property tax bills; therefore

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, as follows:

1. That this Board specifically finds and hereby determines that the uncontrolled growth of vegetation and/or the refuse and debris on each of the said properties listed above constitute a nuisance within the meaning of Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87, and the Board directs that notice of this action be given to owners of the said property and lienholders in the manner required by Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87;
2. That this Board hereby orders the owners of said property to remove and abate the nuisances within seven days after notice of this order is given to the owners and lienholders of record and within four days after notice of this order is given to the owners and lienholders of record for properties previously determined to be a nuisance. If said nuisances are not removed and abated by the said owners, or if no agreement for removal and abatement is reached between the Township and the owners and lienholders of record within four or seven days after notice is given, the Zoning Inspector shall cause the nuisances to be removed, and the Township shall notify the County Auditor to assess such cost plus administrative expense to the property tax bills for the said parcel, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 505.87;
3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT COLERAIN TOWNSHIP CONSULTANT

This agreement is made and entered into this 13th day of October, 2015, by and between **Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio**, 4200 Springdale Road Colerain Township, OH 45251, and Becky Reno, hereinafter referred to as ("Contractor").

TERM

1.01 This agreement shall be effective upon execution by both parties. The term of this agreement will be from October 14, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

SERVICES

2.01 The Contractor shall serve as a consultant to Colerain Township with respect to zoning, planning, nuisance, property maintenance, inspections and enforcement.

COMPENSATION

3.01. The Contractor shall receive compensation of **\$35.00** per hour as approved by the administrator.

3.02 Contractor shall furnish the Township with a W-9, completed with relevant and correct taxpayer identification information to facilitate payment.

3.03 Contractor hereby acknowledges that she is considered to be an independent contractor and shall receive no benefits generally afforded to Colerain Township employees. In addition, Contractor is solely liable for the payment of all Federal, State and Local income taxes or other taxes arising out of this Contract.

3.04 Contractor acknowledges and agrees to abide by all Federal, State, and/or local criminal or civil laws, statutes, or requirements throughout the duration of this agreement, and failure to do so may result in immediate termination of the agreement, and the pursuit of any other remedy available, whether in law or in equity, by the Township.

3.05 Contractor agrees to indemnify and hold the Township harmless as a result of any claims arising from or related to his/her performance of any duties related to this agreement.

TERMINATION

4.01 This agreement may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, at any time, without prior notice. In the event of termination, the terminating party shall notify the other, in writing, of intent to cancel said agreement, with said cancellation effective immediately upon issuance of the same.
