OPENING OF MEETING

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

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Chief Denney said that Officer Melissa Cooper has been assigned to the FBI terrorism task force and has been nominated for FBI Director's Award for her work on the Christopher Cornell case. He said they are very proud of her and being nominated for the national award is very impressive.

Chief Denney also offered an update on their recruitment efforts, in a desire to increase diversity. He said they have the mentorship program and scholarship. He said they have doubled the number of minorities in the department, with the department now at 9.52% minorities and 16% of females. He said these are quality people, who met our usual standards.

Mr. Milz said that he met with Andy Holzhauser from Greater Cincinnati Energy Alliance about an economic development program called the PACE program (Property Assessed Clean Energy) which allow Township business access to special capital for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects. The Township's role would be to create a special improvement district to allow pay back of the capital over time. He will bring a resolution in the future to support the idea in concept.

Mr. Milz said he's also met with the Regional Trails Alliance about their plan to provide non-motorized trails in the region, from Dayton to Indiana to Northern Kentucky. He said they requested a resolution from the Board to endorse the idea in concept, which he will bring at a future meeting.

Mr. Rowan said that both projects have no cost impact on the Township.

Mr. Meloy said that two weeks ago, the Hamilton Count Public Health Department presented the Township's health assessment and this document is now available on our website. The WeThrive partnership has provided signs to post on streets around the township. The strategic planning document is almost completed and representatives will be at the April 28 work session to present a summary.

Mr. Birkenhauer said that last night the Northern Kentucky University students did the second round of community surveys and will be making more calls this week. The full report will be ready May 15. He said this has been a great process and NKY has been a great partner.

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Mr. Birkenhauer said the gateway project will be starting in two weeks and will take 4-6 weeks to build. He said the bid was awarded and they had the preconstruction meeting for burying utilities. He said this will start in a month. He asked all drivers to please be patient and vigilant at night as the crews are working.

Mr. Rowan said that he will have a guest column in the Northwest Press and he and Mr. Lange will be on a Waycross program to discuss the funding of Township street repairs. He will also hold a focus group on the subject and invites residents to contact him to be a part of this.

TRUSTEES' REPORTS

Mr. Deters said the administration team should be commended for starting this process. He said the survey results should be interesting. He said that now that the Public Safety departments have stabilized, we can now dive into the other areas. This is one of our most critical years. Our roads might not get the attention as public safety, but important to engage the public.

Ms. Rinehart thanked Mr. Birkenhauer for the Colerain Ave. update.

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NEW BUSINESS PUBLIC SAFETY

Acceptance of Donation

Mr. Meloy requested the Board accept a donation of a LifeFitness Summit Trainer, valued at \$2,699, from the owner of Professional Fitness Services, LLC, Gregory Deaton.

Approval to Purchase Public Safety Vehicle

Mr. Meloy requested the Board approve a purchase of a Ford Sport Utility Police Vehicle (SUV). This vehicle will be used for the front line patrol by both police officers and paramedics. This partnership of medics and police officers will facilitate a proactive public safety response, to include life safety (medical) call response, follow-up for CARE and Alzherimer's registrants, as well as a newly created partnership that will provide onsite triage and assessment for heroin/opiate overdose incidents. It will provide a quicker life safety response.

The cost of this vehicle will be split between the fire and police departments, due to the public safety partnership. This purchase was included in the 2015 operating budget for each department and will be purchased at a cost of no more than \$30,000.

Chief Denney requested approval to purchase one 2015 Ford Taurus to add to the marked unit fleet. This purchase will be funded substantially from insurance settlements received for previous not-at-fault crashes. He estimated the final cost to be about \$500.

Appointment of Full-time Police Officer

Chief Denney requested the Board hire Brandon Ellis as a full-time police officer. He will assume the spot left vacant by the creation of full-time code-enforcement officer. He is a 2011 graduate of Western Hills High School, a 2014 graduate of the Great Oaks Police Academy and is currently working as an armed security officer. If approved, his salary will be \$47,520.28 and will serve a one-year probationary period. His appointment is effective April 26, 2015.

Mr. Ritter said he will be voting no on this. He said it is inconsistent with the statements the Board made during the JEDZ campaign.

Mr. Deters said that this is a public safety component, with the Broken Window Theory. From an operational standpoint, enforcement of codes will make the community safer

He said the cab and chassis has exceeded its useful life and is budgeted for a body remount in 2015. The cost of the cab and chassis purchased directly from Fuller Ford of Cincinnati using state contract pricing is \$27,471.50. The removal of the body from the old chassis, refurbishment and remount of the body on the new chassis is \$48,500 by Braun Industries, the original body manufacturer in Van Wert, Ohio.

The tablets are for the purpose of electronically capturing patient care information during emergency medical incidents. The current tablets have been instrumental during the fire department's first five-years of electronic reporting. However, expired warranties, new technology, reliability and excessive repair costs have

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directed us down a path that supports the replacement of these computers. The cost is \$48m991 from MobileTek Consulting of Cincinnati.
