

RESOLUTION CERTIFYING PROPOSED FIRE LEVY RENEWAL QUESTIONS TO HAMILTON COUNTY AUDITOR

The Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, met in Regular Session on the 12th day of July, 2005 at the Colerain Township Government Complex with the following members present:

Mr (Mrs) Rielage moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS the electors of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, in the general election held in November, 2000, approved an additional tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the purpose of providing fire protection and emergency medical services in Colerain Township, which levy was at a rate not to exceed 4 34 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 43 4 cents on each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of 5 years; and

WHEREAS The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio Therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, two thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to renew the aforesaid five year 4 34 mill levy originally submitted to and approved by the voters at the general election held in November, 2000, said levy being an additional tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Colerain Township for the purpose of providing fire protection and emergency medical services in Colerain Township, for a period of an additional five (5) years; be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees requests that the Hamilton County Auditor certify that the Board the current tax valuation of the subdivision, and the dollar revenue that will be generated by a renewal of the levy described above for a period of an additional five (5) years; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the submission of the question of this proposed tax levy renewal is authorized by Ohio Revised Code §5705 19
