**RESOLUTION HIRING DANIEL MELOY AS POLICE CHIEF**

Whereas, Steven Sarver has resigned his position as Chief of Police, and it is necessary for the Board of Trustees to appoint a replacement; and


Whereas, the Board of Trustees believes that Daniel Meloy, currently a lieutenant in the Colerain Township Police Department, and its Acting Chief, is well qualified for the position of Chief.

Now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Colerain Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:


1. The Board of Trustees does hereby find that Daniel Meloy is well qualified for the position of Chief of Police, and specifically finds that he has the qualifications previous specified by the Township for that position, and his appointment would be in compliance with ORC Sec. 505.49.
2. The Board of Trustees does hereby appoint Daniel Meloy as Chief of Police of the Colerain Township Police Department and of the Colerain Township Police district pursuant to ORC Sec. 505.49
3. Daniel Meloy shall serve at the pleasure of the Board. His annual salary shall be \$80,000, and he shall receive the same benefits as other full time employees of the Township. His salary and benefits may be reviewed and modified from time to time as the Board may determine.
4. This appointment shall be effective on Jan. 8, 2008, provided that Daniel Meloy has taken his Oath of Office by that time.




