Fire Station 109 will be dedicated and named in honor of our retired fire **Chief Bruce Smith**. The dedication ceremony will begin at 10:30am. Light refreshments will be available at the station following the ceremony.

Chief Smith (ret.) assumed the reigns of the Fire Department following the retirement of Chief Corky Snyder in 1986. During the next 29 years, **Chief Smith** would lead the Department through major changes with the implementation of Paramedic Services in 1989, expanding the career firefighter ranks, Homeland Security Preparations following 9/11 and the building of a new fire station in the Pleasant Run Farms district of the Township. **Chief Smith** retired from the Department earlier this year.
