



News Release for Colerain Fire

For Immediate Release

Date: **December 27, 2014**

Colerain fire units were dispatched to reports of smoke coming from a mobile home in the **9000 block of Brookside Drive** at approximately 08:50 this morning. Responding units were advised by the Hamilton County Communications Center that the home was potentially occupied. The home was pushing heavy thick smoke from windows and doors on their arrival.

The fire was quickly knocked down after forcing entry into the residence. Crews performed a rapid interior search for any victims and located a deceased victim inside the living area of the home. The fire was extinguished quickly and fire investigators from the Colerain Police, Hamilton County and the Ohio Fire Marshall's office were called to the scene. As with any fatal fire, the Hamilton County Coroner's office was also notified.

The investigation into the cause and origin of the fire is just getting underway; therefore there are no preliminary findings to report. The name of the victim is being withheld pending notification of the next of kin.

Colerain fire units were assisted on scene by crews from Springfield Township and Green Township fire departments. There were no firefighter injuries reported.
