



News Release for Colerain Fire

For Immediate Release

This is Captain Steve Conn reporting on a one alarm structure fire located in the 7100 block of Broadmore that occurred this morning. At approximately 09:20 am the Hamilton County Communications Center received a call for a reported fire in the residence. Colerain fire units encountered a small fire in the front living room area of the single family home. Neighbors advised that the house was undergoing renovation and nobody was home at the time.

A vigilant neighbor noticed smoke coming from the front of the home and called 911. He then proceeded to knock out the front window and attempted to extinguish the fire with a garden hose. Firefighters entered the home and quickly extinguished the remaining fire. The fire was brought under control in approximately 5 minutes. There were no injuries. Several pets were in the home at the time of the fire including a dog, ferret and a silver tailed fox but all were unharmed.

Damage to the structure is estimated to be less than \$5,000. The actual cause of the fire is still under investigation but has been determined to have started on or around a living room sofa.
