



News Release for Colerain Fire

Colerain Fire crews responded to a reported vehicle fire last night in the 3000 block of Shadycrest Drive. Hamilton County Communications Center received a call at approximately 04:00 am stating the vehicle was on fire in a parking lot near the above address. On arrival crews found the fire had already been extinguished, however their investigation has determined the fire to be intentionally set.

Witnesses reported seeing several suspects attempting to light the vehicle on fire. Their descriptions have provided good intelligence to the investigators who are aggressively pursuing and following up on the information. In addition to the multiple points of origin, a threatening message had also been written on the rear window of the vehicle.

The Colerain Police Department is leading the investigation. If anybody has any information concerning the above incident or witnessed any suspicious activity in the area last night, they are encouraged to call Colerain Police at 513-321-COPS (2677).
