Obergeising Park Closing Information

Due to cleanup operations regarding the pipeline oil spill in the Oak Glen Nature Preserve, the Colerain Township Administration has **CLOSED** the Obergeising Soccer Complex (formerly Dravo Park) at 9225 East Miami River Road until the operations have concluded. The Township has offered the use of the park and its facilities to the agencies involved with the cleanup, investigation and mitigation of the environmental concerns related to the spill. The current plan is for the park to remain CLOSED for at least the next 7-10 days while the park is cleaned and restored.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause to our citizens and patrons of our soccer complex, but the provision of a safe and convenient base of operations for these responding agencies is a priority.

Colerain Township is committed to providing a fun and safe environment for all who visit our parks. We invite anyone wishing to enjoy a fun-filled outing to visit any other Colerain Park; the closest of which is Heritage Park located at 11405 East Miami River Road, approximately 4 miles east of the Obergeising Park.
