



Ohio Department of Transportation Projects Impacting Colerain

- D8 Signal Replacement (PID 94749)
 - Work Description: Upgrade traffic signals at various locations in District 8, including US-27 & Springdale and US-27 & Galbraith.
 - Status: Right of way acquisition is underway and construction is slated to begin in the summer of 2016.
 - Total project cost is approximately \$2.6m.

- HAM-27 from IR-275 to Struble (PID 84437 and 92555, Project #14-0275)
 - Work Description: Widen US-27 to extend the southbound right turn lane to the westbound IR-275 entrance and to provide a third through lane on northbound US-27 beginning north of the westbound IR-275 exit and ending in the right turn lane to Struble
 - Status: Utility relocation is substantially complete, and construction work is underway. Work is slated for completion in the summer of 2015.
 - Total project cost is approximately \$3.9m and is being constructed by John R. Jurgensen Company.

- HAM-275 from IR-74 to just east of the US-27 bridge at MP 34 (PID 82976, Project #13-3015)
 - Work Description: plane, repair, and pave IR-275 from IR-74 to just east of the US-27 bridge at MP 34.
 - Status: Work is about 75% complete and is slated for completion in the fall of 2015.
 - Total project cost is approximately \$32.4m and is being constructed by John R. Jurgensen Company.

- HAM-275 from just east of US-27 bridge at MP 34 to the ramps to Winton Road (PID 82972, Project #14-0560)
 - Work Description: plane, repair, and pave IR-275 from just east of US-27 bridge at MP 34 to the ramps to Winton Road
 - Status: Work has begun this spring and is slated for completion in the fall of 2015.
 - Total project cost is approximately \$13m and is being constructed by John R. Jurgensen Company.

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
