Chief Daniel P. Meloy of the Colerain Police Department and Sheriff Simon L. Leis Jr. of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department announce the arrests of several individuals as a result of an undercover drug investigation.

Detectives with the Colerain Police Investigative Unit received information involving drug trafficking within an apartment building located at 2800 block of Glenaire Drive in Colerain Township. During the investigation, undercover detectives were able to make numerous controlled purchases of heroin at the apartment building.

Arrested during the investigation were the following suspects;

1. Fred Seay of Colerain Township with 3 counts of Drug Trafficking
2. Tiras Jones of Forest park with Drug Trafficking and Drug Possession
3. Gary Anderson of Colerain Township with Drug Trafficking
4. Ronald Brown of Lawrenceburg, Indiana with Drug Possession
5. Amber Carpenter of Colerain Township with Drug Possession
6. Carmichael Hamilton of Colerain Township with open warrants
7. Adonis Washington of Colerain Township with open warrants
8. Clyde Cook of Colerain Township with open warrants
9. Two juveniles, both of Colerain Township, with Drug Possession

During the investigation detectives recovered marijuana, heroin, and numerous drug paraphernalia items. Also seized for forfeiture was a vehicle and currency.
