7. Any other documents required per the application and as requested by the City.

When the documents are received in this office and verified as complete and accurate the contractor will be added to the City of Dearborn Heights Residential Rehabilitation Program Contractor List. Homeowners receive a copy of the list when their project goes out for bid. This list is provided as a courtesy to the homeowner. The homeowner is not required to use this list.
