THE FINAL DAY TO WITHDRAW IS 4:00 P.M., FRIDAY APRIL 28, 2017

WHEN FILING FOR THE ELECTION YOU MUST SUBMIT TO CITY CLERK'S OFFICE:

- Affidavit of Identity - 2 copies (Must be notarized)
- Petitions bearing at least 100 signatures; maximum of 200 signatures of registered voters in Dearborn Heights.

- Blank Nominating Petitions (Return to City Clerk's Office)
