

ORDINANCE NO. 12-4104

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Decatur, in the State of Alabama, as follows:

SECTION 1: That a general tax for the municipal tax year beginning October 1, 2012 of six-tenths of one per centum (6 mills) on the assessed valuation of all property of every kind and description located and situated within the corporate limits of the City of Decatur, Alabama, and subject to taxation by the said City and liable therefor under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, be and the same is hereby levied and laid for general municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: That a special tax for the municipal tax year beginning October 1, 2012 of thirty-six one hundredths of one per centum (3.6 mills) on the assessed valuation of all property of every kind and description located and situated within the corporate limits of the City of Decatur, Alabama, and subject to taxation by the said City and liable therefor under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, be and the same is hereby levied and laid as a special school tax, and said school tax, when collected, shall be applied exclusively for the public schools of said City.

SECTION 3. That an additional ad valorem tax for the municipal tax year beginning October 1, 2012 of nine-tenths of one per centum (9 mills) on the assessed valuation of all property of every kind and description located and situated within the corporate limits of the City of Decatur, Alabama and subject to taxation by the said City and liable therefor under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, be and the same is hereby levied, and laid, and the proceeds of which, when collected, shall be applied exclusively for school purposes, including without limiting the generality thereof, the construction, enlargement, improvement and equipment of public school buildings and acquisition of land therefor.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published one time in THE DECATUR DAILY, a newspaper published and having general circulation in the City of Decatur, Alabama.
