

**ORDINANCE NO. 12-4105**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DECATUR, ALABAMA,  
AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That Section 14-62.1 of the Code of Decatur, Alabama is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14-62.1

“(a) In conformity with the provisions of Act 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2006 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Decatur, Alabama, exempts “covered items” from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in August (August 3, 2012) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (August 5, 2012).

(b) This section shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2006-574, except that the time period shall only be as specified in subparagraph (a) above and not for all years thereafter.”

**Section 2.** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Decatur, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and publication as provided by law.
