

**ORDINANCE NO. 12-4111**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DECATUR, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Code of Decatur, Alabama is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered Section 14-62.3, which section reads as follows:

“Section 14-62.3.

(a) In conformity with the provisions of Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the 2012 Regular Session, providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday, the City of Decatur, Alabama, exempts “covered items” from municipal sales and use tax during the same period, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in July 2012 (July 6, 2012) and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday (July 8, 2012), and in subsequent years beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the Friday of the last full weekend of February each year and ending at twelve midnight the following Sunday.

(b) This Section shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256.”

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Decatur, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective on its approval and publication as provided by law.
