

RESOLUTION NO. 12-260

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Decatur, Alabama that a public hearing shall be held at 402 Lee Street, NE, Decatur, Alabama on the 4th day of September, 2012 at 6:00 p.m., for the purpose of considering the passage of an ordinance adopting by reference without setting out at length in said ordinance, the following rules and regulations which have been printed as a code or codes in book or pamphlet forms:

“NFPA 101, Code for Safety to Life from Fire in Buildings and Structures, 2009 Edition,” promulgated and published by the National Fire Protection Association Committees on safety to Life, August 2, 2001, together with the annexes, the reference codes and standards, and appendices and indices forming a part thereof, save and except those portions thereof as shall be deleted, modified, amended or extended.

It is further directed that there shall be provided and on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Decatur not less than three (3) copies of such code for a period of not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the holding of such public hearing for use and examination by the public.

Notice of the time, place and purpose of such hearing shall be given by publication of this resolution at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of said hearing, once a week for two successive weeks in THE DECATUR DAILY, a newspaper published and of general circulation in Decatur, Alabama.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-4124

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Decatur, Alabama as follows:

Section 1. That Section 11-1.2 of the Code of Decatur, Alabama is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 11-1.2. - Code—Adoption.

Pursuant to the authority granted to cities and towns by section 11-45-8 Code of Alabama, 1975, there is hereby adopted in its entirety that certain code printed in book or pamphlet form known as NFPA 101, "Code for Safety to Life from Fire in Buildings and Structures," 2009 Edition, promulgated and published by the National Fire Protection Association Committees on Safety to Life, together with the annexes, the reference codes, standards, appendices and indices forming a part thereof, save and except the following portions thereof as shall be deleted, modified, amended or extended as follows:

- (1) Annex B- Elevators for Occupant- Controlled Evacuation Prior to Phase 1 Emergency Recall Operations; and Annex C- Supplemental Evacuation Equipment are all adopted as part of the Code.
- (2) Annex A- Explanatory Material; and Annex D- Informational References, unless also listed and required in Chapter 2 of the Code for other reasons (these portions are to remain part of the Code) are all adopted as informative and as guidelines in the interpretation of the Code, and not as part of the Code.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective on October 1, 2012.
