SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2013 Amendment to Pay Plan

DATE: September 27, 2012

The Personnel Board of the City of Decatur, at its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on September 27, 2012, decided to recommend the following to the City Council for consideration in its deliberation on the City's Budget for Fiscal Year 2013.

Approximately fifty-two percent (52%) of our workforce has topped out (reached the top of our present pay ranges) and do not have an opportunity to receive any further merit increases. This has contributed to an employee morale problem for many years.

Also, as previously furnished to you, at its July, 2012 meeting, the Personnel Board reviewed the results of surveying municipal salaries and consumer pricing trends. The survey indicates that Decatur salaries remain below similarity situated employees in many other cities with many/most at or below 90% of targeted average. In order to achieve competitiveness, salaries need to be addressed across the board. Once most salaries are competitive, specific under compensated classifications can be further addressed.

Therefore, the Personnel Board of the City of Decatur recommends the following to help with the above problem(s):

• Additional Step 11: Add a 2.5% increase of Step 11 to our current Salary Range Schedule.

Please find attached the proposed new Salary Range Schedule, effective October 1, 2012 (the first pay period in Fiscal Year 2013). The Personnel Director is available to discuss this recommendation with you.

Also, the survey results are available in the Personnel Department for council member's review, if you desire. I and/or the Personnel Board are also available to meet with you to discuss these recommendations.
