HOW TO QUALIFY FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Due to the Amended Safer at Home Order now extended until July 31, 2020, and the guidelines from the CDC and Alabama Department of Public Health. The process for all potential candidates will be through scheduling appointments. This process will enable each candidate interested in running for a municipal office to have their time and ensure the safety and that of everyone who does business with this office. **The Qualification Period remains the same July 7, 2020 – July 21, 2020, during regular hours of operation, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday – Friday.** To accommodate each potential candidate on Monday, July 6, 2020: beginning at 10:00 a.m., we will begin scheduling appointments on a first-come, first-serve basis.
