Item 1. Chairperson Johnson called the meeting to order at 02:04pm.

Item 2. Approve the minutes from the last meeting.

Chairperson Johnson asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the November 5, 2021 TCC meeting. Mr. Teague made a motion to approve the minutes as presented with a second by Mr. Bodley. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 3. Adopt Resolution 22 – 01 (Tabled from last Meeting) adopting the Alabama Performance Management Agreement

Mr. Hellums explained that this was tabled from the last meeting. He also explained that this is a document laying out the performance measures and the implementation of said measures.

Mr. Borden made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Bodley. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 4. Adopt Resolution 22– 08 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase the cost on the following project.

Resurfacing on SR-3 (US-31) from Thomas L. Hammonds Road to SR-304

Mr. Hellums explained that this is an increased cost. Mr. Teague explained the project should be underway in the spring.

Mr. Teague made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Borden. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 5. Adopt Resolution 22– 09 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase the cost on the following project:

Resurfacing on SR-36 from New Cut Road (MP 16.210) to SR-3 (US-31)

Mr. Teague made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Borden. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 6. Adopt Resolution 22– 10 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Sidewalks along SR-3 (US-31 / 6th Avenue) from Moulton Street to Wilson Street in Decatur

Mr. Hellums explained that this a TAP grant to improve the sidewalks along 6th Avenue and Decatur will supply the match. He also explained this is part to the Decatur Beautification project.

Mr. Borden made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Teague. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 7. Adopt Resolution 22– 11 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase funding (RW) on the following project:

Replace Roadway Culvert and Approaches on West Morgan Road over Bakers Creek

Mr. Hellums explained that this project has an increased cost associated with the Right-of-Way and Morgan County will supply the match.

Mr. Teague made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Bodley. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 8. Adopt Resolution 22– 12 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to increase funding (CN) on the following project:

Resurfacing on CR-684 (Church Street) from Somerville Road to Riverview

Mr. Teague explained that the increased funds will go to relocate and replace a waterline under a Utility Budget. Mr. Hellums explained that there will be no cost increase to the construction budget but that a separate utility budget will be applied.

Mr. Teague made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Wright. The motion carried unanimously.

Item 9. Adopt Resolution 22– 13 to amend the FY 2020 - 2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add the following project:

Section 5311 Transit CARES Act N Central AL Regional Council of Governments (Support Equip) FY 2022

Mr. Hellums explained that this is part of the transit rural allotment. There will be not match needed.

Mr. Borden made a motion to approve the resolution with a second by Mr. Bodley. The motion carried unanimously.
