1. An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District to provide technical assistance in implementing soil and water conservation measures for the City of Euclid and other such advisory services as needed and agreed for the year 2023 with the option to extend each year for five years (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail)

**Comments: This would authorize a MOU with Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District to provide technical assistance in 2023.**

2. An emergency ordinance enacted by the City of Euclid, Cuyahoga County, Ohio hereinafter referred to as the MUNICIPALITY, in the matter of the hereinafter described improvement and requests the cooperation of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY. (Sponsored by Councilperson Wojtila by request of the Director of Public Service)

An ordinance amending Euclid Codified Ordinances Chapter 767 “Security Guards” of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid to provide for the registration of armed security guards and businesses who engage same and to require a uniform when acting as an armed security guard. (Sponsored by Councilperson Tanner) (Referred to Safety Committee) (Sent to Council by Safety Committee with recommendation for passage as amended)

**Comments: This would require all security guards to wear identifying uniforms.**

4. An ordinance enacting Chapter 768 “Video Surveillance Systems for Apartment Complexes” of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid to require apartment complexes to install video surveillance systems and provide access to the Euclid Police Department. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail) (Sent to Safety Committee) (Sent to Council by Safety Committee with recommendation for passage as amended) Ord. (144a-22)

**Comments: This would require video surveillance systems at apartment complexes of 50 or more units.**

5. A resolution amending the Council Committees and assignments for the January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023 term of the Council of the City of Euclid. (Sponsored by All Members of Council) Res. (003-23)

**Comments: This would amend the Council Committees and assignments through the end of 2023.**
