An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District to provide technical assistance in implementing soil and water conservation measures for the City of Euclid and other such advisory services as needed and agreed for the year 2026 with the option to extend for one (1) year.

WHEREAS, the services provided by the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District, to the City of Euclid are beneficial and necessary and cannot be currently provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the services for 2026 will not exceed Twenty-One Thousand One Hundred and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$21,175.00) and if the Memorandum of Understanding is extended for 2027 the cost of the services will not exceed Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$23,300.00); and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District will provide storm water pollution prevention monitoring on construction sites covering one acre or more; perform storm water plan reviews (SWP3) for development projects; construction plan review, as requested; perform field reviews of construction sites and water quality facilities; provide written technical advisory reports for plan submissions and field inspections; and

WHEREAS, the services provided by the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District per the Memorandum of Understanding affect the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Euclid.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Mayor be, and she is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District to provide technical assistance in implementing soil and water conservation measures for the City of Euclid and other such advisory services as needed and agreed for the year 2026 with the option to extend for one (1) year. The memorandum of understanding shall be approved by the Director of Law and be on file with the Clerk of Council.

Section 2: That based upon the anticipated level of work involved, the fee for services shall not exceed Twenty-One Thousand One Hundred and Seventy-Five Dollars (\$21,175.00) in 2026 and Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$23,300.00) in 2027 if the option to extend occurs.

Section 3: That funds to pay for this expenditure are to be derived from the 510 Water Reclamation Permits and Fees account and is a budgeted expense.

Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Euclid, and provided it receives the two-thirds vote of all members of Council elected thereto, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or her designee, to enter into a purchase agreement with The Ohio Desk Company dba Ohio Desk 1122 Prospect Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44115 for the purchase, delivery and installation of Steelcase office furniture and related items at a total cost of One Hundred Eight Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-One Dollars and Sixty-Nine Cents (\$108,381.69) for use by the Recreation Department at the Community Recreation and Wellness Center.

WHEREAS, the City of Euclid is constructing the Community Recreation and Wellness Center to promote an active and healthy community; to provide structured and supervised activities for Euclid's youth; to promote educational opportunities for all residents; and to enhance public safety; and

WHEREAS, as a new facility, the Community Recreation and Wellness Center, requires office furniture and related items throughout the facility, including but not limited to, the lobby, offices, and program rooms; and

WHEREAS, because of the design of the Community Recreation and Wellness Center and its operations, the furniture in the lobby and the check-in counter needs to be manufactured to meet the requirements of the Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the furniture being purchased is manufactured by Steelcase and Ohio Desk is an authorized Steelcase dealer; and

WHEREAS, the contracted pricing schedule for the Steelcase equipment has been competitively bid through the Sourcewell Purchasing Cooperative so competitive bidding by the City of Euclid is therefore waived; and

WHEREAS, the funds for this contract will be derived from Recreation Capital Fund (Fund 320); and

WHEREAS, the furniture being purchased will be used on a daily basis by the Recreation Department in the operation of the Community Recreation and Wellness Center and therefore affects the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Euclid.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Euclid, State of Ohio:
