**Item 1. Ordinance 105-23.** An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a one (1) year agreement with Cuyahoga County for care and housing of Euclid’s charged prisoners from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail)

**Item 2. Resolution 106-23.** A resolution dedicating city-owned land along Green Creek south of Euclid Avenue as a city park and naming the park “Green Creek Preserve”. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and All Members of Council).

Ordinance 110-23.** An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a contract for a five-year operating lease with Yamaha for seventy-five (75) golf carts at an annual cost not to exceed \$49,028.00. 
