Item 2. Ordinance 0100-23. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance of the City of Euclid to enter into a contract with Zurich Insurance Company written through the firm of McGowan Insurance, 20595 Lorain Road, Fairview Park, OH 44126, insuring municipal buildings from October 1, 2023 through July 1, 2024 in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Fifty-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$121,055.00).

A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid, or her designee, to apply, accept and expend Ohio Department of Development Energy Efficiency Program funds in an amount up to Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars and 00/100 Dollars (\$250,000.00) for the purpose of municipal building energy improvements in the City of Euclid.
