LEGISLATION

Item 1. Ordinance 140-24. An emergency ordinance, for the benefit of the Euclid Municipal Court, authorizing the Mayor or her designee to enter into a Managed Services Agreement with DataServ Integrations, LLC dba DataServ, 31280 Viking Parkway, Westlake, Ohio 44145, for three (3) years at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Fifty-Six Cents (\$257,673.56) during said three (3) year contract period. An ordinance declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, describing the public improvements to be made that directly benefit such parcels, requiring the owners of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes, and establishing a Euclid Avenue TIF District #2 public improvement tax increment equivalent fund for the deposit of such service payments, and declaring an emergency. An emergency ordinance enacted by the City of Euclid, Cuyahoga County, Ohio hereinafter referred to as the MUNICIPALITY, in the matter of the resurfacing of Richmond Road from the Southern Corporation Line to Brush Road in the City of Euclid and requests the cooperation of the County of Cuyahoga, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, with financial assistance for said project, and authorizing the Mayor, or her designee, to execute all documents and agreements necessary to receive and expend said assistance from the COUNTY.
