(Sponsored by Planning and Zoning and Councilperson Tanner)

Motion by Councilman Gresham to send to Second Reading, second by Councilman Jarosz. Vote failed 5/4 to send to a Second Reading.

Motion to close debate by Councilwoman Steele, second by Councilman Tolton.

Motion to forego the second and third reading by Councilwoman Hannum, second by Councilman Jarosz.

Ordinance passed with a vote of 8/1.


