Item 1. Resolution 106-25. A resolution to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and the United States Army Corps of Engineers for approval of the proposed shore structure in the submerged lands in Lake Erie adjacent to the property located at 30 East 252nd Street, Euclid Ohio 44132, bearing Permanent Parcel Number 644-07-014. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)

Item 2. Emergency Ordinance 107-25. An emergency ordinance adopting a moratorium in the City of Euclid prohibiting the acceptance of applications for, and the granting of, zoning approvals, building permits, and certificates of occupancy for any building, structure, use, or change of use for “group housing facilities” as set forth in the Euclid Codified Ordinances, a “residential facility” as defined in Ohio Revised Code Section 5119.34 and for other similar homes as set forth in this ordinance for a period not to exceed six (6) months in order to allow the City of

Euclid to review its Zoning Code and other codified ordinances relative to such uses.

(Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)

Emergency Ordinance passed with a unanimous vote.


