**Item 1. Ordinance 074-25 – Second Reading.** An ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Development to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for labor and materials necessary for the construction of the East 215th Street Trail Improvements Project. (Tabled at last meeting).** An emergency ordinance authorizing the Public Service Director of the city of Euclid or his designee to enter into a contract with Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc., 7615 Bond Street, Solon, Ohio 44139, for the milling and paving of East 233rd west of Chardon Road in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$57,802.50.) (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Tolton.)
