**Item 1. Resolution 091-25 – Second Reading.** A resolution granting a use district exception, pursuant to Chapter 1375.01(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid, to Sherrie L. Zagorc, applicant, to establish and operate a studio apartment residential use within a commercial structure in a U4-Local Retail or Wholesale District, Permanent Parcel Number 641-16-001, 391 E. 200th Street, Euclid, Ohio 44119.
