ITEM 1: Emergency Ordinance 009-26 - An emergency ordinance authorizing all actions necessary to support the continuation of a governmental electric aggregation program with opt-out provisions pursuant to section 4928.20 Ohio Revised Code, authorizing the Mayor to execute an Energy Supply Agreement with Dynegy Energy Services, 6555 Sierra Drive, 1-W-1 Irving, Texas 75039. ITEM 2: Emergency Ordinance 010-26 - An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a one-year professional services agreement with McCaulley & Company, 19660 Roslyn Drive, Rocky River, Ohio 44116, to provide both grant writing and government relations services to the city of Euclid, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars (\$102,000.00) for the term March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027. ITEM 3: Emergency Ordinance 011-26 - An emergency ordinance renewing the moratorium on the acceptance and processing of applications for zoning approvals, building permits, and certificates of occupancy for any building, structure, use, or change of use that would enable the cultivation, processing, distribution, or sale of adult use cannabis in the City of Euclid for a period not to exceed six (6) months. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)

ITEM 4: Emergency Ordinance 012-26 - An emergency ordinance renewing the moratorium prohibiting the acceptance of applications for, and the granting of, zoning approvals, building permits, and certificates of occupancy for any building, structure, use, or change of use that would be associated with the distribution or sale of vaping/e-cigarette products and prohibiting the commencement of the actual distribution and sale of such products for a period not to exceed six (6) months in order to allow the City of Euclid additional time to study the effects of such products on citizens and to determine whether the adoption of regulations relating to such products are warranted. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)
