ITEM 4: Emergency Ordinance 029-26 - An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service of the City of Euclid to enter into an agreement with GPD Group, 520 South Main Street, Suite 2531, Akron, Ohio 44311, for the purpose of performing construction administration and inspection services for the 2026 Asphalt Road Program, 2026 Concrete Road Program, East 217th Street Waterline Reconstruction Project, the Coulter Avenue Waterline Project and coordinating and finalizing the remaining construction administration and inspection work associated with the completion of the 2025 Asphalt Road Program and the East 220th and East 221st Street Improvements in the amount of Five Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$549,942.00).
