ADMINISTRATION REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

- Thank you to everyone that put together the Memorial Day activities, especially to the Veterans Organizations, the staff, the Service Department, Laura Kidder and her team, to Council, to all the Directors and Chiefs and to everyone that walked in the parade and made it a special day.
- Thank you to the Euclid Veterans Association on the celebration of their 80th anniversary on Saturday the 23rd of May. Unfortunately it was also their final salute as they have made the decision to cease operations of the Euclid Vets. They leave a strong legacy in our community and have donated quite a bit of money to our local and veterans associations.
- Euclid Public Library will have their grand re-opening ceremony on June 6th from 12-5. Ribbon cutting at 12:30pm
- Euc Flea begins on June 13th from 12-4 at Shore Cultural Centre.
- This Saturday is our Saturday Matinee at Lakeshore Cinema – doors open at 11, movie is at 11:30am. The movie is Sheep Detective.
- Downtown Euclid Improvement Corporation monthly matinee will be Saturday, June 6th at 11am.
- We received work from the Welcome Home Ohio Fund that we will receive to the Community Improvement Corporation, \$402,000 that will help the city purchase homes to be used for the Open Door Euclid Program. \$100,000 for

the Euclid Heritage Trail Project, \$700,000 for the Sims Park Playground Improvement Project and \$100,000 for the Euclid Memorial Pool renovation. Thank you to Senator Kent Smith and Representative Eric Cineberg for advocating for us, to the Planning and Development Dept and our grant writers McCauley and Company.


