<b>Sent to a Third Reading</b>	<p>1. A resolution granting a Use District Exception, pursuant to Chapter 1375.01(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid, to 21 Hoops, LLC, applicant, on behalf of 20001 Euclid Industrial, LLC, owner, to operate a bar in a U6-Industrial and Manufacturing Use District, Permanent Parcel Number 646-25-002, 20001 Euclid Avenue, Euclid, Ohio 44117. (Sponsored by Planning and Zoning Commission.)</p> <p><b>Comment: This grants a Use District Exception for the property at 20001 Euclid Avenue allowing the operation of a bar in a U6 – Industrial and Manufacturing Use District.</b></p>	<p>Res. (110-25)</p>
<b>Passed 7/0 112-2025</b>	<p>2. A resolution authorizing all actions necessary to support the extension of a governmental Natural Gas Aggregation Program with opt-out provisions pursuant to Section 4929.26, Ohio Revised Code, directing the Mayor, or her designee, to execute a supply agreement amendment with Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. dba IGS Energy. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)</p> <p><b>Comment: This would authorize the Mayor to sign a natural gas supply aggregation agreement with Interstate Gas Supply.</b></p>	<p>Res. (114-25)</p>
<b>Tabled</b>	<p>3. An emergency ordinance adopting a moratorium in the City of Euclid prohibiting the acceptance of applications for, and the granting of, zoning approvals, building permits, and certificates of occupancy for any building, structure, use, or change of use for “group housing facilities” as set forth in the Euclid Codified Ordinances, a “residential facility” as defined in Ohio Revised Code Section 5119.34 and for other similar homes as set forth in this ordinance for a period not to exceed six (6) months in order to allow the City of Euclid to review its Zoning Code and other codified ordinances relative to such uses. (Sponsored by Council President Jarosz.)</p>	<p>Ord. (107-25)</p>

**Comment: This would place a six (6) month moratorium on approving any new group home applications to allow time to study their impact in the community.**

**Passed** 4. A resolution authorizing the Director of Finance of the City of Euclid to take advances on the collection of Real Estate Taxes, Personal Property Taxes, and Special Assessments. (Sponsored by All Members of Council by request.) **Res.**

**Comment: This would allow the Finance Director to receive tax advancements in 2026 from Cuyahoga County.**

**Passed** 5. A resolution adopting the City of Euclid Disaster Recovery Plan for matters in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 9.64(C). **Res.**
