Passed 9/0 36-2025	1. An emergency ordinance vacating Old Highland Road in its entirety and reserving a sanitary sewer easement in a portion thereof. (Sponsored by Planning & Zoning Commission.) Comment: This vacates Old Highland Road, which is property owned by the Cleveland Metroparks, and reserves a sanitary sewer easement for the City.	Ord. (039-25)
Passed 9/0 51-2025	2. An emergency ordinance amending Ordinance #25-2025 which makes the annual appropriation for all expenditures for the City of Euclid for the period ending December 31, 2025. (Sponsored by Council President Jarosz per request of the Finance Director.) Comment: This amends the annual appropriation ordinance.	Ord. (052-25)
Passed 9/0 52-2025	3. A resolution allowing the employees of the Euclid Police Department that participate in the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund and are members of the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 18 the voluntary purchase of service credit as provided in the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Comment: This will allow members of the Euclid Police Department that are police officers to purchase service credits through the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.	Res. (051-25)
Passed 9/0 53-2025	4. A resolution allowing the employees of the Euclid Fire Department that participate in the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund and who are members of Local #337, International Association of Fire Fighters the voluntary purchase of service credit as provided in the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)	Res. (055-25)

Comment: This will allow members of the Euclid Fire Department that are fire fighters to purchase service credits through the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

- Passed 9/0 54-2025** 5. A resolution proclaiming May 2025 as Foster Care Awareness Month in the City of Euclid, recognizing and encouraging all residents throughout our community to support efforts to improve the foster care system. (Sponsored by All of Council.) Res. (053-25)

Comment: This declares May 2025 as Foster Care Awareness Month.

- Passed 9/0 55-2025** 6. A resolution to adopt the Solid Waste Management Plan Update (2026-2040) for the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste Management District. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Director Knecht.) Res. (054-25)

Comment: This adopts the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District's Solid Waste Management Plan Update.

- Passed 9/0 56-2025** 7. A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to execute and submit a grant application for up to One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources NatureWorks grant program for improvements to Mavec Park. (Sponsored by Councilpersons Steele and Gresham per request of the Planning and Development Director.) Res. (056-25)

Comment: This authorizes the Mayor to apply to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for grant funds for Mavec Park.

- Sent to Executive and Finance Committee** 8. A resolution granting a use district exception, pursuant to Chapter 1375.01(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid, to Euclid Office Campus, LLC, applicant, to establish and operate a multi-family residential use within a commercial structure in a U4-Local Retail or Wholesale District, Permanent Parcel Number 648-52-003, 26250 and 26300 Euclid Avenue, Euclid, Ohio 44132. (Sponsored by Planning and Zoning Commission.) Res. (057-25)

Comment: This grants a Use District Exception for the property at 26250 and 26300 Euclid Avenue allowing multi-family residential use in a U4 – Local Retail or Wholesale District.

- Passed 9/0 57-2025** 9. A resolution authorizing the Director of Public Service of the City of Euclid, or his designee, to accept and expend funds from the Ohio Attorney General's Shine A Light on Dumpers grant program in an amount up to Eight Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$8,335.00) for the purpose of educating the public about the impacts of illegal dumping and to deter future illegal dumping. (Sponsored by Councilperson Wojtila by request) Res. (058-25)

Comment: This authorizes the Director of Public Service to accept and expend funds from the Ohio Attorney General's Shine A Light on Dumpers program.

- Passed 9/0 58-2025** 10. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Euclid Shade Tree Commission to set a ticket price of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for the Euclid Shade Tree Commission's 2025 Pond and Garden Tour that showcases gardens and gardeners throughout the City of Euclid. (Sponsored by Councilperson Hannum.) Ord. (059-25)

Comment: This allows the Shade Tree Commission to set a ticket price for the 2025 Pond and Garden Tour.
