<b>Passed 9/0 1-2026</b>	1.	A resolution setting forth the Council Committees for the January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027 term of the Council of the City of Euclid. (Sponsored by All Members of Council.)  <b>Comment: This legislation assigns Council members to various committees and appoints members to city boards for the 2026 - 2027 term.</b>	Res. (001a-26)
<b>Passed 9/0 2-2026</b>	2.	A resolution establishing a President Pro Tem for the January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027 term of the Council of the City of Euclid. (Sponsored by Council President Jarosz.)  <b>Comment: This legislation names Councilperson John Wojtila as President Pro Tem for the 2026 – 2027 term.</b>	Res. (002-26)
<b>Passed 9/0 3-2026</b>	3.	A resolution authorizing the Director of Planning and Development or his designee to accept and expend grant funds totaling Ninety-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty-Three Dollars (\$98,723.00) from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources 2025 Urban Forestry Grant program for activities related to the planning, maintenance, and increase of the City of Euclid’s tree canopy and related matters. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.)  <b>Comment: This authorizes the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources that will be used to plan, maintain and increase the City’s tree canopy.</b>	Res. (003-26)

4-2026**      4.      An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a one-year agreement with Cuyahoga County for the period January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 whereby the County will pay the costs for counsel assigned to represent indigent persons charged with municipal code violations in the Euclid Municipal Court. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.)      Ord.

**Comment: This authorizes the Mayor to enter into a one year contract with Cuyahoga County for the payment of assigned counsel fees when an indigent defendant is charged with a violation of the Euclid Codified Ordinances.**

5-2026**      5.      An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to advertise for bids and to enter into a contract for labor and materials necessary to provide and install exterior surveillance cameras on Euclid City-owned properties for the completion of the Euclid Municipal Complex Security Camera Enhancement project. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)      Ord.

**Comment: This authorizes the Mayor to advertise for bids and enter into a contract, as approved by the Board of Control, for the installation of exterior surveillance cameras around the Euclid Municipal complex.**
