<b>Passed 7/0 19-2026</b>	1.	An emergency ordinance which makes the annual appropriation for all expenditures for the City of Euclid for the period ending December 31, 2026. (Sponsored by Council President Jarosz per request of the Finance Department)  <b>Comment: This will establish the 2026 budget for all departments in the City of Euclid.</b>	Ord. (019a-26)
<b>Passed 7/0 21-2026</b>	2.	An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to transfer a certain parcel of real property commonly addressed as 24025 Glenbrook Boulevard, Euclid, Ohio 44117 (PPN 650-08-016 and 650-08-017) in the City of Euclid from the City to the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio. (Sponsored by Councilperson Tolton by request.)  <b>Comment: This authorizes the transfer of the residential property at 24025 Glenbrook Boulevard, Euclid, Ohio to the Community Improvement Corporation for redevelopment purposes.</b>	Ord. (021-26)
<b>Passed 7/0 22-2026</b>	3.	A resolution declaring the necessity of controlling the blight and disease of shade trees within public rights-of-way of the City, including the planting, maintaining, trimming and removing of such trees; establishing the boundaries thereof in accordance with the provisions of Section 727.011 of the Ohio Revised Code; providing for the assessment of the cost of those services. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.)  <b>Comment: This is a declaration that an assessment to fund tree lawn tree maintenance and management is needed and the initial step in the statutory process to approve the assessment.</b>	Res. 23-2026**      4.      An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Development or his designee to sign an agreement with Knowles Municipal Forestry to perform tree maintenance services for the City of Euclid in the amount of Seventy-Six Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$76,180.00) and to sign any other documents necessary to complete said work. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum by request.)      Ord.

24-2026**      7.      An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District to provide to the City of Euclid technical assistance in implementing soil and water conservation measures and other such advisory and educational services, known as the PIPE Program, as needed and agreed for the years 2026 - 2031. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)      Ord.
