An ordinance authorizing the sale of Permanent Parcel Number 650-36-029, vacant land at 24670 Hawthorne Drive, from the Euclid Land Reutilization Program, to Kenneth T. and Meghan Fischer for the amount Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), as authorized by Ordinance No. 97-2023. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Gresham.) Comment: This authorizes the transfer of a land bank parcel at 24670 Hawthorne Drive to the neighboring owners for their personal use once both properties are consolidated into one lot.	Ord. (018-26)

A resolution to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and the United States Army Corps of Engineers for approval of the proposed shore structure in the submerged lands in Lake Erie adjacent to the property located at 19751 Edgecliff Drive, Euclid Ohio 44119, bearing Permanent Parcel Number 641-05-012. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Cosgriff.) Comment: This would allow a shore structure adjacent to the property located at 19751 Edgecliff Drive to assist the residents with erosion control.	Res. (014-26)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a two (2) month agreement with Cuyahoga County for the care and housing of the City of Euclid’s charged prisoners from March 1, 2026 through May 1, 2026. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Comment: This extends for two months the jail services contract with Cuyahoga County.	Ord. (013-26)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into a one-year contract with Greenwich Insurance Company, 70 Seaview Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut 06902, from April 1, 2026 through April 1, 2027, for police professional liability insurance at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Nine Thousand One Hundred and Thirty-Nine Dollars (\$109,139.00). (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Ord.

Comment: This would allow for the City to purchase police liability insurance coverage for one year.

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to transfer certain parcels of real property owned by the City of Euclid, commonly addressed as 23802 Lake Shore Boulevard (PPN 644-20-001), 23750 Lake Shore Boulevard (PPN 644-20-003), 24100 Lake Shore Boulevard, rear (PPN 644-20-063), Elmwood Drive, rear (PPN 644-20-061), and vacant lot on E. 238th Street (PPN 644-20-054), in the City of Euclid to the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Ord.
