Passed 9/0 31-2026	1. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga County for the care and housing of the City of Euclid’s charged prisoners from May 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027. (Referred to Executive and Finance Committee, which recommended for Passage on 4/13/26.) (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Comment: This authorizes the signing of a contract with Cuyahoga County for jail services for prisoners charged by the City of Euclid.	Ord. (023-26)
Sent to a Third Reading	2. An ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2812, as amended, and the map and map designations, which map and map designations, as amended, form a part of Ordinance No. 2812, as it relates to and designates, U8-Office Building and U4-Local Retail or Wholesale Store use districts, relative to said property. (Sponsored by Planning and Zoning Commission.) Comment: This would amend the rezoning of Permanent Parcel Numbers 648-30-005 and 648-30-003, and portions of Permanent Parcel Numbers 648-30-013 and 648-36-006 to a C-I Campus Institutional use.	Ord. (032-26)
Passed 9/0 32-2026	3. A resolution of intent adopting and approving the attached Program Year 2026 Department of Planning and Development Capital Improvements Plan. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Comment: This provides an update on Capital Improvement Projects being done by the Department of Planning and Development.	Res. (033-26)

Passed 9/0 33-2026 4. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Development to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for labor and materials necessary for the 2026 Sidewalk Replacement Program. (Sponsored by Councilpersons Tanner, Cosgriff, and Wojtila - xby request.) Ord. (034-26)

Comment: This authorizes the Director of Planning and Development to solicit bids and enter into a contract for the 2026 Sidewalk Replacement Program.

Passed 9/0 34-2026 5. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Development to enter into a professional services agreement with GPD Group, in an amount not to exceed Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents (\$94,987.63), for design and engineering services necessary to implement Phase I of the Euclid Heritage Trail Project. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Wallace Tanner.) Ord. (035-26)

Comment: This authorizes the Director of Planning and Development to enter into a design contract for the Euclid Heritage Trail Project.

Passed 9/0 35-2026 6. A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to request, accept, and expend a grant from the Ohio Lake Erie Commission (OLEC)'s Lake Erie Community Grant program for up to Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00) to support removal of invasive plant species at Sims Park. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.) Res. (036-26)

Comment: This authorizes the request, acceptance and expenditure of a grant that will address the removal of invasive plants at Sims Park.

Passed 9/0 36-2026 7. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or her designee, to enter into a five (5) year contract with one (1) year options with GPD Group, 520 S. Main Street, Akron, Ohio 44311 for hourly professional engineering services related to the Sewer Study Implementation Plan. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer.) Ord. (037-26)

Comment: This authorizes the Mayor to enter into a professional engineering services contract with GPD Group to assist with the Sewer Implementation Program that is related to the Consent Decree with the U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA.

Passed 9/0 37-2026 8. An ordinance creating Fund 218 – Opioid Settlement Fund for the receipt of funds from opioid settlements. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.) Ord. (038-26)

Comment: This creates a dedicated fund for opioid settlement funds that will track receipts and expenditures.

Passed 9/0 38-2026 9. An ordinance creating Fund 800 – Community Improvement Corporation Fund for the receipt of funds by the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail) Ord. (039-26)

Comment: This creates a dedicated fund for the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio that will track receipts and expenditures.
