A resolution proclaiming Friday, April 24, 2026 as Arbor Day in the City of Euclid and encouraging all residents throughout our community to appreciate the beauty, value, benefit and significance of trees to our city and to support efforts to protect the city's tree and woodland infrastructure. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.)	Res. (026-26)
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Comment: This declares Friday, April 24, 2026 as Arbor Day.

Passed 9/0 26-2026	2.	A resolution proclaiming April 2026 as Fair Housing Month in Euclid, recognizing and celebrating the 58 th anniversary of the Fair Housing Act, and reiterating the City's commitment to housing without discrimination in the City and to maintaining an inclusive community. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail.)	Res. (027-26)
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Comment: This will declare April as Fair Housing Month.

Passed 9/0 30-2026	3.	A resolution granting a Conditional Use Permit pursuant to Section 1359.03(d)(4) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Euclid, to The Redeemed Christian Church of God, Jesus House, to operate a day care facility at 1469 Dille Road, a U6-Industrial and Manufacturing Districts, Permanent Parcel 646-29-018. (Sponsored by Planning and Zoning Commission.)	Res. (028-26)
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Comment: This would allow for the use of 1469 Dille Road, Permanent Parcel 646-29-018, currently in a U6-Industrial and Manufacturing District, to operate as day care.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service of the City of Euclid to enter into an agreement with GPD Group, 520 South Main Street, Suite 2531, Akron, Ohio 44311, for the purpose of performing construction administration and inspection services for the 2026 Asphalt Road Program, 2026 Concrete Road Program, East 217th Street Waterline Reconstruction Project, the Coulter Avenue Waterline Project and coordinating and finalizing the remaining construction administration and inspection work associated with the completion of the 2025 Asphalt Road Program and the East 220th and East 221st Street Improvements in the amount of Five Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$549,942.00). Comment: This authorizes a contract for construction administration and inspections services for various projects throughout the City.

Comment: This would authorize the transfer of a land bank lot, known as Permanent Parcel Number 650-33-011, to the neighboring owners, Gilberto Pena and Ernesto Luna Camargo.
