| Passed 8/0 40-2026 | 1. An ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2812, as amended, and the map and map designations, which map and map designations, as amended, form a part of Ordinance No. 2812, as it relates to and designates, U8-Office Building and U4-Local Retail or Wholesale Store use districts, relative to said property. (Sponsored by Planning and Zoning Commission.) Comment: This would amend the rezoning of Permanent Parcel Numbers 648-30-005 and 648-30-003, and portions of Permanent Parcel Numbers 648-30-013 and 648-36-006 to a C-I Campus Institutional use. | Ord. Washington for the amount Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), as authorized by Ordinance No. 97-2023. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Hannum.) Comment: This authorizes the transfer of a land bank parcel, which is vacant land, to the neighboring owner located at 500 Babbitt Road for his personal use once both properties are consolidated into one lot. | Ord. Passed 8/0 46-2026 3. An ordinance authorizing the sale of Permanent Parcel Number 641-25-061, vacant land on East 214th Street, from the City of Euclid, to Lashanna Mays for the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00), as authorized by Ordinance No. 97-2023. (Sponsored by Mayor Holzheimer Gail and Councilperson Tolton.) Ord. (046-26)

Comment: This authorizes the transfer of a land bank parcel, which is vacant land, to the neighboring owner located at 927 East 214th Street, for her personal use once both properties are consolidated into one lot.

Passed 8/0 42-2026 4. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to transfer a certain parcel of real property commonly addressed as 20470 Naumann Avenue (PPN 641-21-001) in the City of Euclid from the City to the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio. Passed 8/0 43-2026 5. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Euclid or her designee to transfer a certain parcel of real property commonly addressed as 27861 Euclid Avenue (PPN 648-30-013) in the City of Euclid from the City to the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio. (Sponsored by Councilperson Gresham by request.) Ord. (044-26)

Comment: This allows for the transfer of the real property at 27861 Euclid Avenue from the City to the Community Improvement Corporation of Euclid, Ohio for development purposes.

Passed 8/0 44-2026 6. An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or her designee, to enter into a contract with CDW Government, LLC, 200 N. Milwaukee Avenue, Vernon Hills, Illinois 60061 for the purchase of internet switch computer hardware and related supporting equipment, supporting licenses and service agreements related to the same at a total cost of Two Hundred One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Ninety-Five Cents (\$201,716.95). Comment: This authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of computer hardware, supporting licenses and service agreements.
