JENKINS TURNED OVER TO CHIEF MILLER. CHIEF MILLER DISCUSSED ALARM REGISTRATION & FALSE ALARM MANAGEMENT. CHIEF MILLER SAID THE CURRANT SYSTEM IS NOT EFFICIENT . MUNICIPAL DYNAMICS WILL TAKE CARE OFF EVERYTHING, REGISTRATION, BILLING, WEEDING OUT FALSE ALARMS. CURRENTLY ST. LOUIS, EAST ST. LOUIS, AND OTHERS USE THIS SYSTEM.

MOTION BY JENKINS, SECOND BY THOMPSON, FOR KONZEN TO DRAW UP A RESOLUTION TO INSTRUCT THE POLICE TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE ALARM COMPANY, AND GET AN ORDINANCE STARTED. MOTION CARRIED.
