NOTICE TO BIDDERS

CITY OF GRANITE CITY, ILLINOIS
2010 Sewer Repairs
Sites #2, #5, #7, & #8

Separate sealed bids for sewer repairs to Sites #2, #5, #7 & #8 will be received by the City Clerk in the City Hall, Granite City, Illinois 62040 until 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, June 30, 2010, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Sealed bids should be labeled "2010 Sewer Repairs- Sites #2, #5, #7 & #8" on the outside of the envelope.

The proposed work consists of the following:

Site #2 – 2502 Pontoon Road

Cleaning and televising of the existing 8" line as well as installation of 8" cured in place pipe liner from M.H. #14-28 to M.H. #14-11A. Surface restoration of the site is also included in the repair.

Site #5 – 2459 Pontoon Road

Cleaning and televising of the existing 8" storm sewer from M.H. #14-29 to M.H. #14-30.

Site #7 – 3208 Aubrey

Cleaning and televising of the existing 8" line as well as the installation of 8" cured in place pipe liner from M.H. #3-13A to M.H. #3-58. Surface restoration of the site is also included in the repair.

Site #8 – Costello Lane

Cleaning and televising of the existing 42" storm sewer at designated locations.
Pressure grouting of the existing 42" storm sewer as needed according to video inspection. Surface restoration of the site is also included in the repair.

Bids that are furnished by mail shall be addressed to the City Clerk, City of Granite City, City Hall, 2000 Edison Avenue, Granite City, Illinois 62040.

The successful bidder will be required to agree that not less than the prevailing rate of wages as determined by the Secretary of Labor and made a part of these contract documents shall be paid to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing their work under this contract.

The City of Granite City reserves the right to waive, or not to waive, any irregularities in the bids and to reject any or all bids and to determine which is the lowest and best bid.
