ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

WILSON PARK STATE STREET TRAIL PROJECT

Separate sealed bids for the Wilson Park State Street Trail Project will be received by the Granite City Park District in the City of Granite City, Illinois 62040 until 10:00 a.m. CST, Tuesday, June 22, 2010, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Sealed bids should be labeled "Wilson Park State Street Trail Project" on the outside of the envelope.

The proposed work consists of:

The removal and replacement of an existing Hot-Mix Asphalt walking trail surface, base repair, and all other necessary collateral work to complete the project shown on the plans and as specified.

Bids that are furnished by mail shall be addressed to the Director of Parks and Recreation, Granite City Park District, Wilson Park Office, 2900 Benton Avenue, Granite City, Illinois 62040.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained upon the deposit of \$25.00 for each set. Deposits will be totally refunded to prime general contractors submitting a bid upon return of the plans and specifications in good condition within twenty (20) calendar days after the opening of the bids. An additional non-refundable charge of \$5.00 to cover the cost of postage and handling is required for those contractors requesting plans and specifications be mailed to them.

Plans, specifications and contract documents are also available for examination at McGraw-Hill Construction Dodge/AGC, St. Louis, Missouri and Southern Illinois Builders in O'Fallon, Illinois.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within ninety (90) days of the scheduled time of closing bids.

All proposals must be made on forms furnished by the Granite City Park District.

The successful bidder will be required to execute and present performance and payment bonds in a sum equal to the full amount of the contract. Bids must be for the contract as a whole.

The successful bidder will be required to agree that not less than the prevailing rate of wages as determined by the Secretary of Labor and made a part of these contract documents shall be paid to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing their work under this contract.

The Granite City Park District reserves the right to waive, or not to waive, any irregularities in the bids and to reject any or all bids and to determine which is the lowest and best bid.
